Renew your Restricted Vehicle Authority with the Shire before 30 June

Is your Restricted Vehicle Authority with the Shire of Gingin due to expire?

If so then you need to renew prior to 30 June. All applications for Restricted Access Vehicle (RAV) Permits are now processed and approved by Main Roads WA (MRWA) - Heavy Haulage Section. However, RAV drivers still need to seek approval to use the Shire's roads.

Download and complete a "Restricted Access Vehicle (RAV) Authority Application" form from the Shire's website www.gingin.wa.gov.au/services/operations.aspx.

Please send in your completed application to the Shire (email mail@gingin.wa.gov.au or drop off a copy to either our Gingin Administration Centre or our Lancelin Office) so it can be processed prior to 1 July 2021.
