Ginggin Aquatic Centre Officially Waterwise

The Shire of Ginggin is pleased to announce that its aquatic centre has successfully satisfied all the criteria to be endorsed as a Waterwise Aquatic Centre. The Water Corporation recently congratulated the Shire for its participation in, and commitment to, the Water Corporation and Leisure Institute of WA Aquatics (LIWA Aquatics) Waterwise Aquatic Centre Program, and for leading industry in sustainable water use.

Among the actions taken to improve the centre's water efficiency included the installation of low-flow shower heads, dual flush toilet system, and Waterwise educational signage, as well as landscaping with Waterwise native plants and mulch. Monitoring submeters have also been earmarked for installation shortly, which will record and analyse water use on the potable and pool water feeds, and irrigation solenoid more accurately.

"This is an excellent outcome," said Ginggin Shire President David Roe. "We are mindful that ongoing water conservation practises play an important part in sustainable service delivery for the Shire."

Formal acknowledgement of the endorsement, including presentation of the endorsement certificate, will take place at the LIWA Aquatics State Conference in August.
