Ginggin Shire to Conduct Community Perceptions Survey

The Shire of Ginggin is once again conducting a Community Perceptions Survey to determine current levels of community satisfaction with Shire services and facilities. It will also provide an opportunity for residents to have a say in areas they think should be improved or changed.

“This survey is part of our continuing commitment to engage our community in decision making processes,” said Shire President David Roe. “We recognise the value in community consultation as we strive to make the Shire of Ginggin a better place to live, work and visit, and this is an occasion where residents can supply their honest feedback anonymously.”

The Community Perceptions Survey will enable residents to rate certain services and provide the Shire with information so that appropriate resources are channelled and distributed to where they are needed.

“We want to hear our community’s views and strongly encourage everyone in the Shire of Ginggin to participate in the survey,” Cr Roe added.

Residents can expect the survey mailed to them shortly and there will also be an on-line version to complete on the Shire’s website if preferred. The survey will be open for four weeks, from 4th to 29th July 2016 and is open to all Shire of Ginggin residents 18 years and over.
