Ledge Point Boat Harbour Update

The Shire of Gingin would like to provide an update on the status of the proposed boat harbour facility at Ledge Point.

- The project continues to be subject to ongoing assessment/studies conducted, and jointly funded, by the Department of Transport (DoT) and no approvals have been given as yet.
- Of these assessments, DoT recently completed its Ledge Point Boat Harbour Coastal Processes Stage 1 Assessment Report which has yet to be presented to Council.
- DoT is undertaking Stage 2 of its Coastal Processes Assessment which will provide further design detail and how the development may affect the Ledge Point coast.
- Findings from these reports will then inform the next phase of the project - being the environmental assessment reports and construction drawings prior to grant applications being prepared.
- The Ledge Point boat harbour facility is a long term project (3-5 years) between the Shire of Gingin and DoT.

In addition to the proposed boat harbour, Council also agreed to undertake preliminary design work and costings to develop Old Ledge Point Road to link the town sites of Ledge Point and Lancelin.
