Important Information

Interment in Niches

Internal measurements of niches are 120mm (height) X 120mm (width) X 330mm (depth).

Urns containing ashes MUST have dimensions less than these measurements in order to be accommodated in a niche.

It is strongly recommended that families liaise with the crematorium, either directly or through their funeral director, prior to interment to ensure that the urn used is of an appropriate size.

Interment in Plots

Where ashes are to be interred into a plot with an existing memorial or monument, all due care will be taken to avoid disturbance to the existing structure. However, the Shire of Gingin will accept no responsibility for any damage caused during or as a result of excavations to accommodate ashes interments in graves where a monument or memorial is in place.

- Medical Certificate of Cause of Death/Death Certificate/Coroner's Certificate (whichever applicable)
- Certificate of Identification/Certificate Dispensing with Identification
