### Virtual Rottneest Swim - February 2018



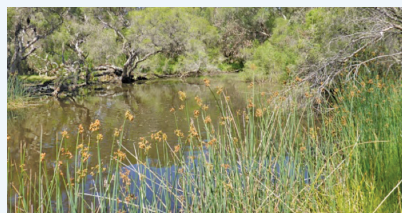
### On the Roads

### Protecting Gingin Brook – Can You Help?



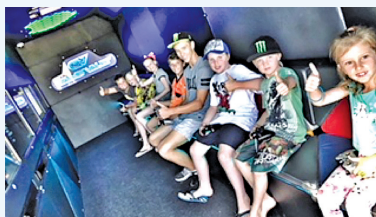
The **Department of Water and Environmental Regulation** have advised that Gingin Brook and its tributaries are one of the State's river systems most impacted by drying climate. High levels of water use from multiple users, coinciding at similar times during hot weather, can exacerbate the impact of low flows on stream health, the environment and other water users.

**Gingin IGA X-Press** is the local supermarket for the community of Gingin. It is currently owned by Andrew and Carolyn Worthington - Carolyn was born and raised in Gingin and Andrew has been in Australia for 9 years and is a qualified chef.

IGA X-Press is not only a supermarket - we now provide fresh baked bread, rolls, pastries and cakes, a dine-in and takeaway service with fresh salad rolls made to order, and hot foods including our recent addition of Rosie's Chicken. The IGA is also the local **newsagency** and **Lotterywest agent**.

Since taking over the IGA two years ago, Carolyn and Andrew have made a few improvements. All the freezers, deli fridges and fruit and vegetable displays have been upgraded to new uprights. The deli has been expanded to include a bain marie for hot food, a pie warmer for Mrs Macs pies, and a self-serve coffee machine with fresh ground coffee beans. A **new stainless steel kitchen** has also been installed.

What used to be a plant nursery many years ago has been transformed into a **café** for those who wish to dine in with a fresh made salad roll, burger or anything else which may take your fancy from the café or takeaway menu.

For businesses or community groups who require **catering** the IGA can provide platters of fresh made sandwiches, rolls, wraps or hot food which can either be picked up or delivered to your meeting.

IGA X-Press opening hours are:

Monday to Thursday from 5.30am to 7pm  
Friday 5.30am to 7.30pm  
Saturday 7am to 2pm  
Sunday 8am to 1pm

The **Saturday hours are due to change** during February to enable the IGA to offer the takeaway service to the community on Saturday night, which of course means you can also grab anything else at the same time.

Also coming your way is a **home delivery service**. The van has been purchased and it will soon be very recognisable on the streets.

Carolyn and Andrew would like to thank the Gingin community for supporting them over the past two years and look forward to seeing you in the shop for many more to come.
